Final Screening Assessments and Risk Management Approaches

In January 2011, the final screening assessment reports for substances in this batch were released in the <u>Canada Gazette</u>, Part I: Vol. 145, No. 3 - January 15, 2011 (PDF Version - 1619 K).

The final screening assessments concluded that one substance in this batch meets one or more criteria in section 64 of the *Canadian Environmental Protection Act, 1999* (CEPA 1999). The

Government proposed to add this substance to Schedule 1 of the *Act*. A proposed risk management approach document was also released on this date for the substance in this batch which met the criteria in section 64 of CEPA 1999.

Draft Screening Assessment Reports and Risk Management Scopes

New information was received from industry or interested stakeholders for each of the 18 substances in this batch. In June 2010, the draft screening assessment reports were released and the related Notices were published in the <u>Acanada Gazette</u>, Part I: Vol. 144, No. 26 - June 26, 2010 (PDF Version - 1699 K). Risk management scope documents were also released in conjunction with these publications.

Launch of Batch 10 and Submissions Received

Information on substances in this batch was gathered from industry and interested stakeholders through a mandatory survey Notice issued under section 71 of CEPA 1999. They were also invited to complete a voluntary questionnaire.

A Notice related to the launch of Batch 10 was published in May 2008 in the *Canada Gazette*. The section 71 Notice applied to all 18 substances in this batch.
