Environment and Development Planning Act (Assignment of Assets, Rights, Liabilities, Obligations and Functions) (Amendment) Regulations, 2017

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by article 7 of the Development Planning Act, and in exercise of the powers conferred by article 8 of the Environment Protection Act, the Minister for Sustainable Development, the Environment and Climate Change and the Parliamentary Secretary for Planning and Simplification of Administrative Processes have made the following regulations with regard to the assignment and transfer of assets, rights, liabilities, obligations and functions of the Malta Environment and Planning Authority:-

Citation.

1. The title of these regulations is the Environment and Development Planning Act (Assignment of Assets, Rights, Liabilities, Obligations and Functions) (Amendment) Regulations, 2017, and these regulations shall be read and construed as one with the Environment and Development Planning Act (Assignment of Assets, Rights, Liabilities, Obligations and Functions) Regulations, hereinafter referred to as "the principal regulations".

2. In regulation 4 of the principal regulations for the words "by the 31st July 2016" there shall be substituted the words "by the 31st July 2017".

3. Immediately after regulation 5 of the principal regulations there shall be added the following new regulation:

6. As from the 1st March 2017, the Environment and Resources Authority established under the Environment Protection Act shall be permanently and exclusively compliance and assigned all enforcement responsibilities as established under Environment Protection Act.".
