The Permanent Interstate Committee for Drought Control in the Sahel (CILSS) is a public international organization created to supervise food security and the fight against the effects of drought and desertification in the Sahel region.

The use of pesticides within the Sahel region is regulated by the Institute of Sahel (INSAH), a specialized institution of the CILSS responsible to coordinate, harmonize and promote agriculture research and natural resources management.
